There was a fight in the Virginia camp one night last week, and the 1st Regt. Conn. V. I. was called out at 1 o'clock to stop the disturbance.

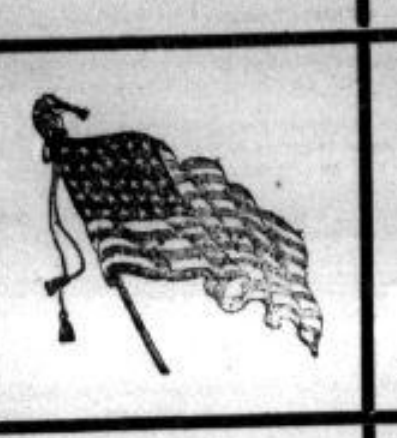

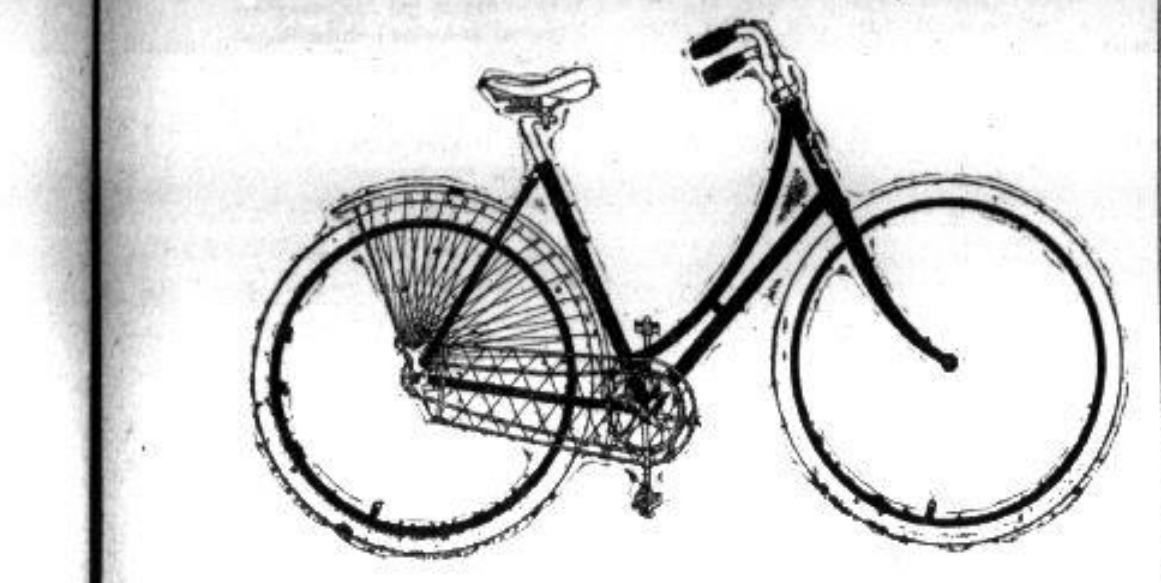
