The annual collection for the year to have been \$9,728.19. The chief sources of revenue were pew rentals, \$2,181; annual fair, \$1,200; offering collections, \$511.93; annual and other collections, \$885.29.

The general revenues of the church were increased on the whole by about \$1,000 during the year.

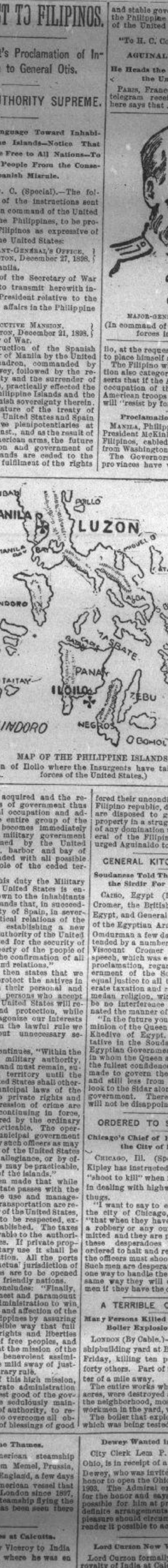

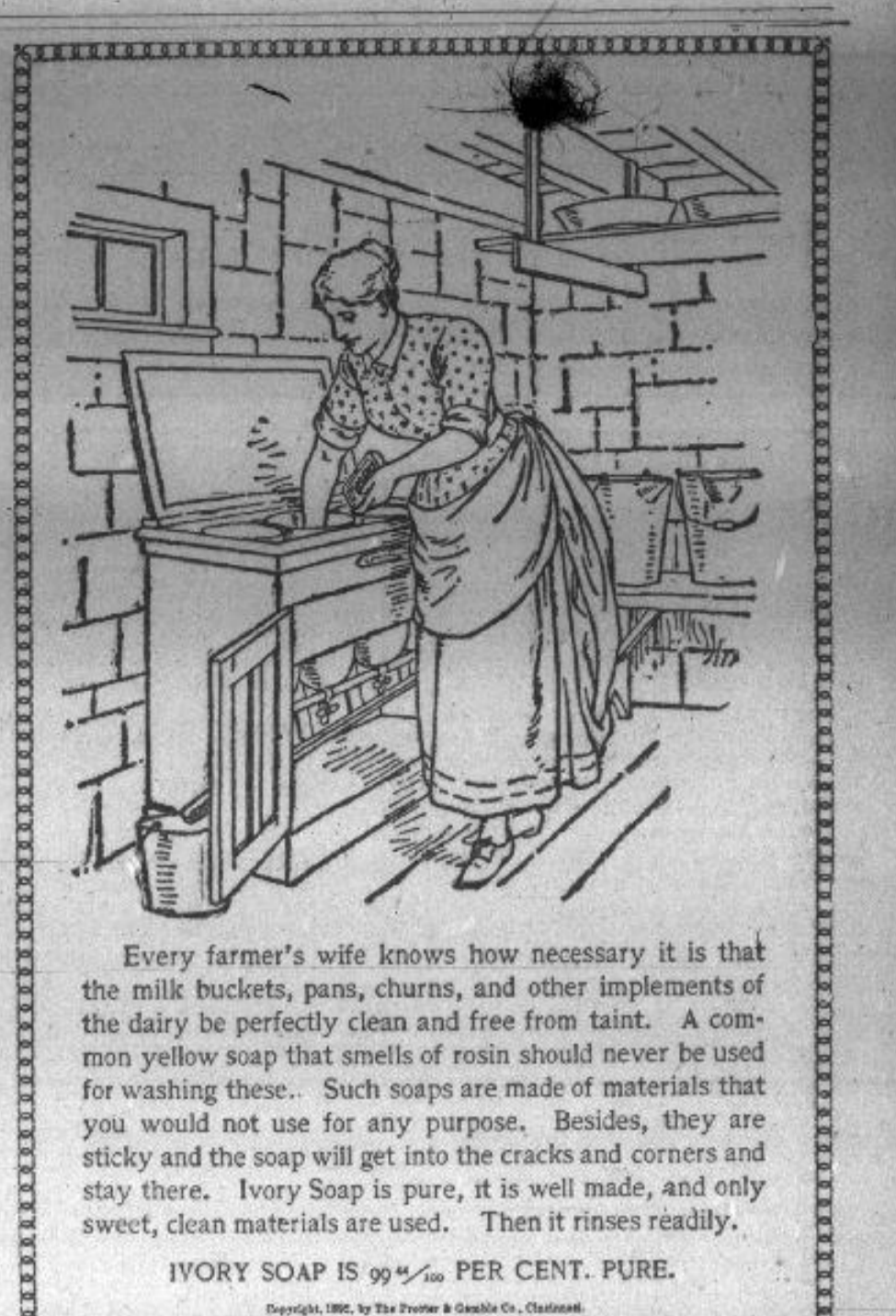
