The London humane societies are agitating against tortoise-shell ornaments because of the torture the animals are subjected to in depriving them of the shell. They are first scalded over a red-hot fire until the shell is softened. The animal is then scalded, and, though the suffering must be intense, one rarely dies, but in a few months grows another shell, of which he is deprived in the same manner. The largest of the shells are obtained in the islands near Ceylon, and is a large part of the industry of the natives.

The information comes from Washington that the American gunboat Wilmington, which is now cruising in Venezuelan waters, is to be sent on an exploring expedition as far up the Amazon river as her draught of about eight feet will allow her to go. The highest point yet reached on the river by an American vessel is Manaos, 850 miles from the mouth of the river, and beyond this point very little is known of a definite character about the great river, which is more than three thousand miles in length. It is believed that the Wilmington will be able to ascend at least to thousand miles of the length of the river, and possibly less she will be enabled to clear up much of the mystery that attaches to the interior of Brazil. Wild stories of great mineral wealth, status of gold and tribes of Amazon warriors have sprung to the region since the days of Pizarro and his followers in the sixteenth century, but it is doubtful if the explorations of the Wilmington will sustain any of these old traditions.

The course of the epidemic of influenza during the present season has been somewhat different from that of former times. Instead of traveling from east to west, almost the contrary has been the case. The disease struck this country in the late autumn and early winter, was next heard from France, Germany and Great Britain and has now appeared in quite a virulent form in Copenhagen, Stockholm and Christiania. Judging from reports that reach us, the brain symptoms appear to be prominent features as noticed among the Scandinavians. It is quite probable that the prevalence of influenza in these northern climes affords some of the most interesting manifestations are much exaggerated.
