PERISH IN ASYLUM FIRE

Over a Score of Orphans Lose Their Lives at Rochester, N. Y. MANY OTHERS BADLY INJURED

Explosion of Boiler Cut Off Supply of Many Children in the Burning Building and Added to the Mortality.

ROCHESTER, N. Y.—Not since the great fire of 1888, in which many persons were killed and many others injured, has such a catastrophe occurred here as that of the burning of the Rochester Orphan Asylum, a three-story structure, at Hubbard Street, and Exchange street, of the nearly 200 inmates of the asylum, nearly thirty perished outright, and many will die from burns and other injuries. A large portion of the asylum building was destroyed.
