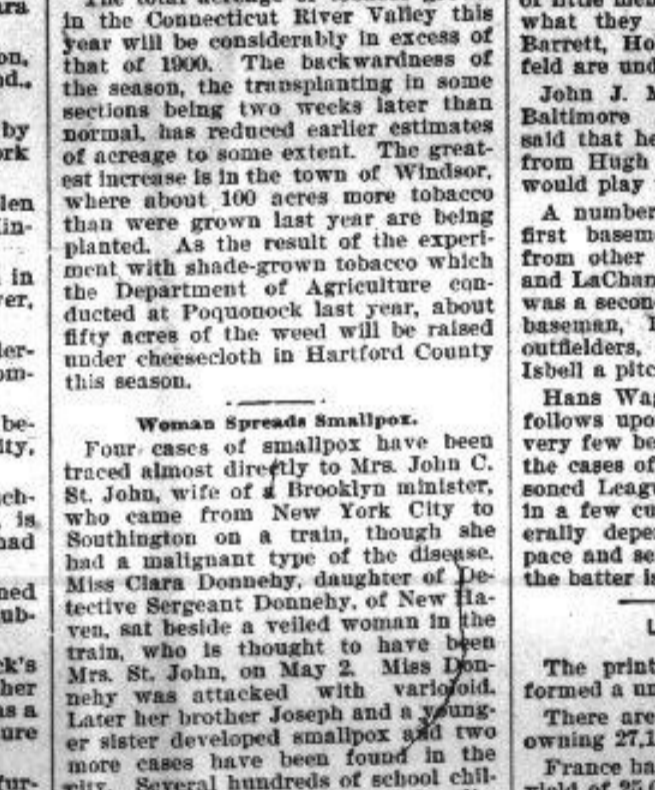
HOUSEHOLD RECIPES.

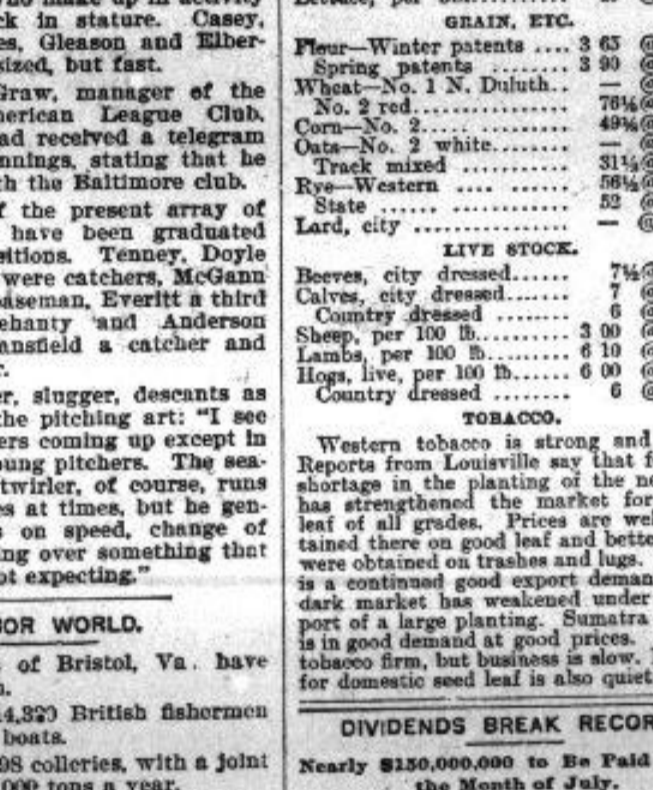
