Take one quart of four ounces, spirits of ammonia two ounces, spirits of camphor two ounces, of pure alcohol eight ounces and sufficient hot water to make a quart of the liquid. Dissolve the sea salt in the hot water and let stand until cool. Pour into the alcohol the spirits of ammonia and camphor. Add the sea salt. With a soft sponge dipped in this mixture wet over the surface of the whole body. Rub vigorously or "blue" or "wax" do not omit this bath. The most refreshing that follow will simply repay the efforts required to prepare it. Alcohol for Lamp Chimneys.
