YESTERDAY MORNING DESTROYED DOUBLE TENEMENT AT CENTER

Near First Alarm

It becomes painfully apparent every time we have a case of any considerable proportions that the city fire department is not equipped to handle the fire in the most efficient manner.

The members of the South Manchester Fire Department had a hard fire to contend with about four o'clock yesterday morning when they responded to an alarm from No. 40 at the corner of Center and Lincoln streets.

It was found that there was a gas leak from the second floor. Captain H. H. O'Neil was appealed by A. S. A. Chief George H. Howe for more pressure and Captain Heeber telephoned to the Old Mill and the pumps were started.

Mr. Dielensneider had his household goods insured through the agency of Robert E. Carney and Mr. Neuman also carried insurance on his household effects through the agency of Thomas D. Faulkner.

The firemen are making complaints loud and long and vigorous because of lack of water pressure at the fire yesterday morning. They claim that in the beginning there was a stream of water from a slight line of hose up to the first story.

Another serious handicap they complain of was the fact that at the start they did not have a ladder at hand that would reach up even to the first story.
