PASTOR RUSSELL IS CHALLENGED
A Complete Answer to the Query "Who Ordained Him?"

The Whole Subject Clarified For the Public Benefit—Charge and Reply Unrepentant.

The time has come for telling the people what the Bible teaches respect to the doctrine of Apostles' Ordination. The doctrine of Apostles' Ordination started in the second century A.D. The Bishop claimed that he had the authority that Jesus gave to the twelve Apostles. Upon this claim they ordained the inferior clergy.

Each denomination at its beginning was opposed by all others; yet each denomination of the clergy were in the past. St. Paul particularly emphasized the fact that he did not receive his commission as preacher and Apostle of Christ from his brother Apostle, but by Divine authority.

No denomination claims that the ordination of its ministers either made or kept them perfect. All admit that there have been and will be failures among their ordained ministers. Neither do they claim that ordination has ever given their ministers superior discernment of Divine Truths. On the contrary, it has injured the clergy by making many of their doctrines and loudly, contrary to the spirit and teachings of Christ and the Apostle; and the laity by leading them to conclude that merely secular matters should engage their attention.

Finally the Pastor showed the true ordination to be the impartation of the Holy Spirit. Whoever receives this has God's authority to be His ambassador and whoevers such show the work of the Holy Spirit upon their hearts and hearts, giving them insight into the Scriptures, and enabling them to be God's mouthpieces, ministers of His Truth.

SWEETBREAD RECIPES.
By Nicolas Seyan, Chief of Brokers' Club, London.
Escalop of Sweetbreads: Trim a sweetbread and cut in four pieces. Trim four large mushrooms and tomatoes. Roll the sweetbread in flour and put in broiler. Turn mushrooms and tomatoes. Butter will your paper bag and arrange the above nicely in the middle. Place one teaspoonful of white sauce on top. Cover with a slice of fat bacon or ham cut very thin. Flavor with sweet herbs as desired. Seal bag and put on broiler in fat pan. Allow twenty to twenty-five minutes.

Sweetbread (Fancy Method): Half a small onion, one slice of carrot, a slice of ham, fat and lean, and a little of the grating, all cut in small dice. A small bunch of sweet herbs and thyme, parsley and bay leaves. Put them in the middle of the paper bag which should be well buttered. Lay your sweetbread, if desired, and around it put three or four mushrooms or three or four tomatoes, skinned and all seed removed. Add a tablespoonful of stock, Madeira or sherry, according to taste. Seal bag tight with string. Allow twenty-five minutes in a hot oven. It color and thick sauce are desired mix a quarter of a teaspoonful of arrowroot with water and add a little burnt sugar coloring. When you open the bag, remove the sweetbread gently. Place on dish. Remove mushrooms, tomatoes, etc., and place around it. Put the whole of the remaining contents of the bag, juice included, in a strainer and press with a wooden spoon. 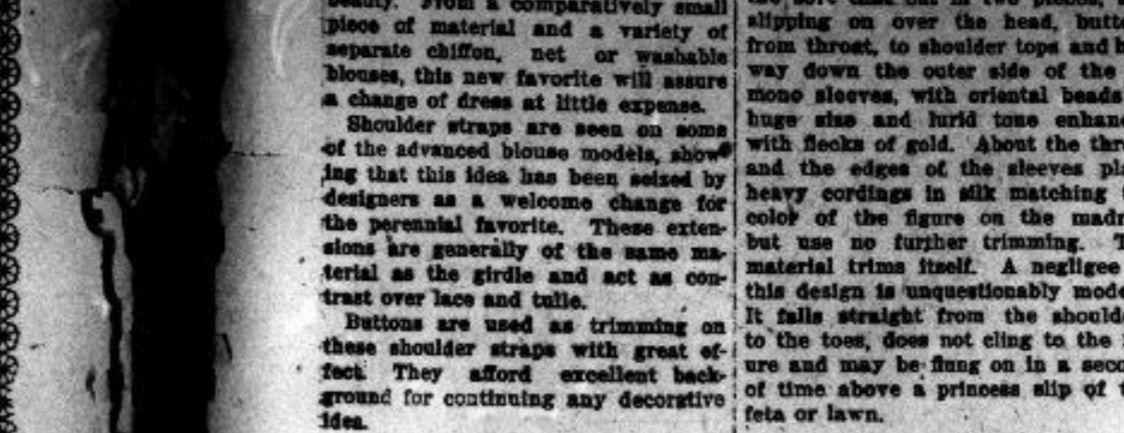
