NO FIRE ENGINE

CLOSER INVESTIGATION REVEALS FACT THAT WATER MAINS ARE TOO SMALL. Would Mean Replacing of Present Water Mains With Others of Larger Diameter.

When the officers and members of Hose & Ladder Company No. 4 voted to petition the fire district for a motor driven fire engine they apparently did not look into the question very thoroughly.

When Chief Stanton of the Norwich fire department was here recently he said that in the city with the use of a fire engine they were able to get one fair sized stream of water from a four inch water main such as they have on the outside of the city and on a few of the side streets.

In looking over the size of the mains of the South Manchester Fire District some interesting figures are gleaned. For instance: the largest mains, 12 inches in diameter, are run from the Porter reservoir to Foster street, to East Center to the Center.

On West Center to Olcott street there is a 6-inch main and from the Olcott street to the main meadows a four inch main. Trotter, Orchard, Knox and the other streets branching off from West Center street are 4-inch mains.

It will be seen by these figures that some portions of the fire district are fairly well equipped with proper water mains while on others it would seem that they are largely without for fighting purposes.

In talking with a member of the Hartford board of fire commissioners a local insurance agent said that South Manchester should get reduced insurance rates with its new automobile fire fighting apparatus and a new engine.
