April 18 Set Aside by Governor for Trees and Birds
Governor Simon E. Baldwin has issued the following proclamation setting April 18 as Arbor and Bird Day. By His Excellency Simon E. Baldwin.

A Proclamation
Pursuant to the laws of this state requiring that some day in the Spring of each year be set apart for the purpose of tree and bird planting, I designate Friday the eighteenth day of April 1913 as

Arbor and Bird Day
and I direct the officers in all our public schools to make it the occasion of explaining to their classes why this anniversary has been constituted, and what it means.
I urge also the people of the state at large to give some thought, upon the day hereby appointed to what they each can do to promote the culture of trees and the protection of birds; remembering that the small as Connecticut, its geographical position, assuring a climate belonging partly to the North and partly to the South, bring with it her many more varieties of trees and birds than are found in any other state in the American Union.

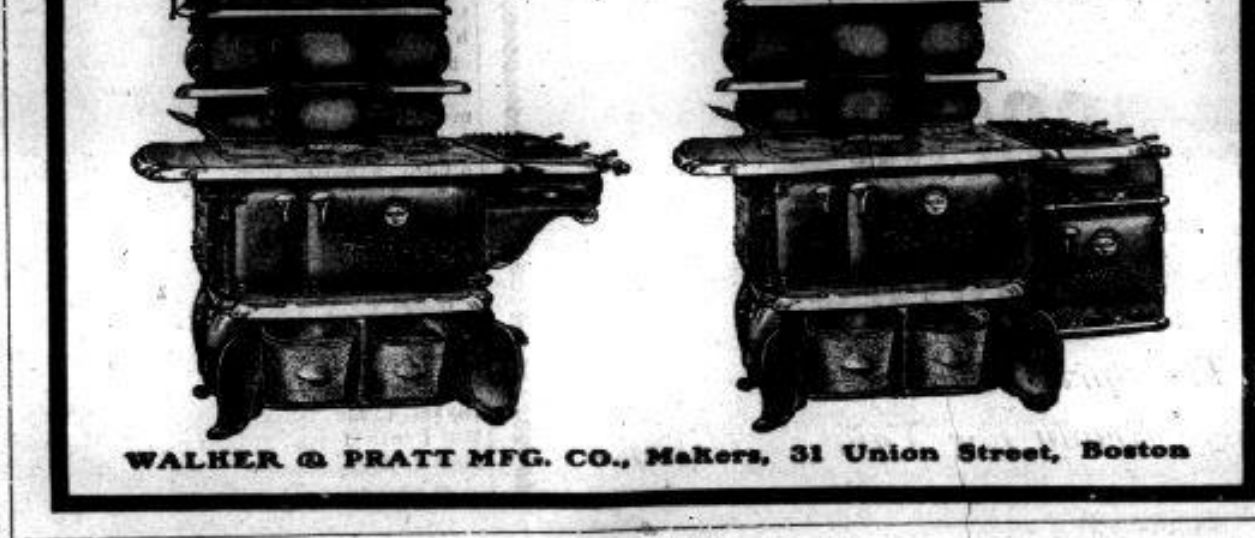
