LITTLE GEORGIE KELLY LOOSES LIFE AT GLOBE HOLLOW. George Kelly, the six-year-old son of James and Mrs. Keller of Summit street, was accidentally drowned in the Globe Hollow reservoir yesterday afternoon about three o'clock.

The boy in company with two youngsters about his own age named Ward was walking along the bank of the pond to the rear of the South school house. In playing near the water the Kelly boy fell and as the water is about seven feet deep there his friends could not save him.

Sherrwood Hense was on the opposite side of the pond picking berries and when he heard the cry of the little boy he ran to the scene but was unable to reach the Kelly boy who was floating in the water.

The neighbors nearby came over and sought to save the boy but were unable to reach the Kelly boy with a long pole and he was brought to shore. All efforts to revive the boy back to life failed.

Medical Examiner Dr. W. R. Tucker was summoned and after viewing the body gave the cause of death as accidental drowning and the body was turned over to Walter Brothers for burial.

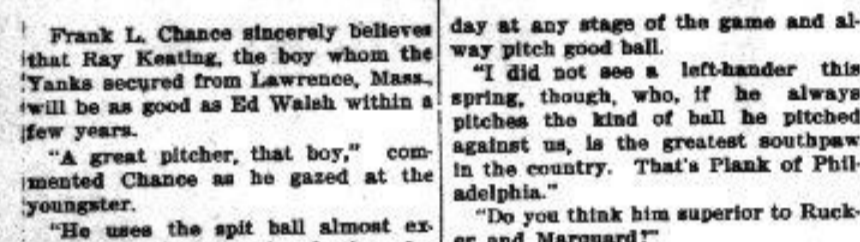
