SELECTMEN APPROVE SPECIFICATIONS FURNISHED ENGINEER BOWEN

The News herewith prints the information of property owners the specifications for concrete walks, concrete curbing and granite curbing as drawn up by Engineer J. Frank Bowen. The specifications were approved by the board of selectmen at its meeting last Wednesday evening.

It is imperative that all permanent sidewalks be built according to these specifications and under the supervision of the town engineering department.

GRANITE CURBING

Granite curb one and one half feet high, four (4) feet long, twenty (20) inches deep and five (5) inches wide on top and bottom.

CONCRETE CURBING

Concrete curbing shall be twenty (20) inches deep, eight (8) inches wide at bottom and five (5) inches wide at top with one (1) inch radius on the outside edges.
