WHAT, WHEN AND HOW TO EAT

Congress Takes Up High Living Cost.

By EUGENE CHRISTIAN, F. S. D.

In a number of my previous articles I have discussed the operation of the high cost of living in a general way, but inasmuch as it is now becoming a sort of national issue and has finally filtered its way through to the federal government, it seems an opportune time for some one to go somewhat into detail in regard to this question.

When we examine critically the high cost of living we find that the articles that make living so exceedingly expensive are nearly all things that could be dispensed with, not only without harm, but which would supply some profit to the general health. For example, we will take the most question, the second largest item in our national food supply, the flour.

Most is not food in the true sense of the word. Most is the result of a process which is not a natural one. There is no element of nutrition in it that cannot be produced in a much better and purer form. This statement can be confirmed in the laboratory or by any reputable chemist or scientist.

The best of most contains only about 30 per cent nutrition—approximately 20 per cent protein and 10 per cent carbohydrate. The remaining 70 per cent is water and non-nutritive tissue. The average flour contains 10 per cent of water and 30 per cent of protein and 10 per cent of carbohydrate.

As an example we will take common sugar. This is the most common about 5 cents per pound. It is well known among food specialists and doctors who specialize in the food question that the liberal use of sugar is the primary cause of a vast number of diseases.

Health is the nation's greatest asset, and food is the greatest factor in health. Therefore it seems that the food question should be considered by our national congress from all sides. It seems that the federal government should be interested in the selection of the most nutritious and healthful articles.

All of the foods necessary to reproduce man are made from a few of our commonest foods. The following are the most important: wheat, corn, soybeans, and cottonseed.
