FAVORS MERIT SYSTEM

CONGRESSMAN LONGERAN'S STRONG SPEECH FOR ASST POSTMASTERS

Oppose on Floor of House Their Removal From Classified Service—Bill Would Have Jeopardized Positions of Geo. West and Miss Hall of This Place.

Congressman Augustine Longeran took an active part in the debate in the House of Representatives in Washington while the post office appropriation bill was under discussion. There was a local interest in this measure, in that Section 6 would have placed outside of the classified service the positions of assistant postmasters; this would mean that the places filled by the efficient assistant postmasters at the South Manchester and Manchester offices might...

The civil service is adopted by many industrial and commercial organizations as well as municipal and State governments. Such a system now exists in Connecticut. A further evidence of the growth of the popularity of the system is found by the action of Senators and Representatives in holding preliminary examinations for candidates for appointment to Annapolis and West Point. I have made satisfactory tests of this plan.

Patrons of both offices are of one opinion regarding the faithful services of George West and Miss Margaret Hall, the present incumbents in the assistant postmasterhips in the local offices. There is no questioning that Mr. Longeran reflected local sentiment in the Congressional Record, as follows:

Mr. Speaker, the bill under consideration in the main meets with my approval. It has many excellent features. It liberally provides for our rapidly expanding and efficient Post Office Department. The section providing for compensating employees for injuries received, without their neglect, while on duty, and similarly for the payment of some of the money to their representatives in case of loss of life during the hours of employment, is in line with modern progress.

The paragraph providing for express delivery service in towns and villages having post offices of the second and third class that are not by law now entitled to free delivery service should stand. The residents of the country have the rural free delivery and those of the larger communities have the city free delivery. Residents of many of our towns and villages do not have free delivery service, but they are entitled to it. The fact that they do not reside in towns with a population of 10,000 or over is not the justification for their being denied the service. The experimental service is working satisfactorily and should be continued.

It is to be regretted that the rural free delivery carriers is provided for, but it is insufficient. In the district which I have the honor to represent six carriers report as follows: Length of route and net annual income: 21.5 miles \$486.00; 22.5 miles \$504.00; 23.5 miles \$522.00; 24.5 miles \$540.00;
