THE CONSUMER'S DOLLAR AND WHAT IT BUYS

A Chance For Economy and Comfort Sense.
C. B. LANE.
With the increase in the price of many of our common foodstuffs, amounting to many instances from 25 to 30 per cent, the problem of keeping the family budget supplied with food is becoming more important and more difficult to solve every year.

The household provider should not only know how to buy economically, but also how to use the food he has bought. It is in the use of food, in order that the nutrients in the meat be properly balanced for the needs of the body. The situation then shifts down to the kitchen, where the purchaser of food and the intelligence of the cook, for good food is often spoiled in the cooking, and good food is frequently wasted. Both of these are important because of their influence on the cost of living.

To illustrate what I mean by intelligent use of a minimum food supply, we will take a public demonstration of her methods in a kitchen, starting with the question of the cost of living. The women of the town, being skeptical, challenged her. The challenge was promptly accepted. Four men who had established records in the kitchen were selected, and the food was placed before them. After the meal the others agreed it was the most appetizing and satisfactory meal they had ever eaten. They were astonished when they learned that the cost had been only 42 cents, shown as follows: Barley soup, 6 cents; delicious beef, 10 cents; potatoes, 2 cents; onions, parsley and seaweed, 3 cents; dessert, a fruit trifle, 10 cents.

The following table shows what the consumer's dollar will buy and how far in selection affects household economy. Each of these contains the same amount of nutritive material as the other.

EQUIPPING A TRUCK FARM

The amount and kind of equipment needed for a truck farm will depend upon the size of the tract, the soil, and the kinds of crops to be grown. The foundation equipment in soil work, good tools, and a good tractor are essential to the success of a truck farm. There must be plows, harrows, and cultivators suited to the type of soil to be farmed and harness and harnesses for the machinery and the crops. Special tools for planting and cultivating and harvesting particular crops will also be needed. If early crops require transplanting, a good sprayer and insecticide are also necessary. The equipment must include wash, canvas and lumber for huts and cold frames.

FEEDING FOR FERTILE EGGS

Fertile eggs must come from vigorous, healthy hens. The diet and exercise are essential to vigor and must be those of a normal hen. We should bear in mind, however, that the diet in feeding and watering makes serious inroads upon our profits, and proper feeding reduces this expense, but with the use of proper equipment and the use of the dry feed and grain for our fowls according to certain definite rules of husbandry. Recently those of us who have studied the habits of our fowls have been led to conclude that, as far as the hen is concerned, there is a wide difference between a scientific and a practical ration and a palatable one.

Individual taste is as marked in fowls as in human beings, so if we feed our fowls to be healthy and contented we must cater to their tastes. The best method has been done in a simple, inexpensive way. If the proper adjustment was made, so that the fowls had a choice of feed, the fowls would eat what they liked, and the fowls would be healthy and contented.
