The board of selectmen held two busy sessions last Monday, one in the afternoon and another in the evening and although it was 12:30 Tuesday morning when adjournment was taken there was a long list of important matters that had not even been touched upon.

At the afternoon meeting Selectman Willis was the only absentee. After approving the minutes of previous meetings communications were acted upon.

Ninth District Attendance Officer. Upon recommendation of the Ninth District School committee George Lyman of 5 Huntington street was appointed special constable and attendance officer of the district to fill the vacancy made by the resignation of J. D. Henderson, Sr. Mr. Lyman was formerly attached to the police department of New York City and has been a resident of this town for the past two years. The compensation for this service is to be 25 cents for each turn reported by the officer.

In a communication from L. A. Howard of Hartford the board was informed that Mr. Howard could do nothing towards the proposed widening of Florence street as he is contemplating selling all the holdings of the A. S. Bailey estate on that street.

Will Have Bubblers. A communication from Miss Mary Cheney gave the town the authority to install a bubbler on the drinking fountain at Main street and Hartford road and Miss Cheney volunteered to pay the bill. A bubbler will also be attached to the drinking fountain at Pine street and Hartford road at town expense.

Orangemen Will Celebrate. Permission was given Washington Loyal Orange Lodge to construct a room at Orange Hall on East Center street from Mt. Nebo on the afternoon of July 11 when the anniversary of the Battle of the Boyne will be celebrated by the local orangemen. The anniversary comes on July 12, but the celebration will take place on Saturday, July 11.

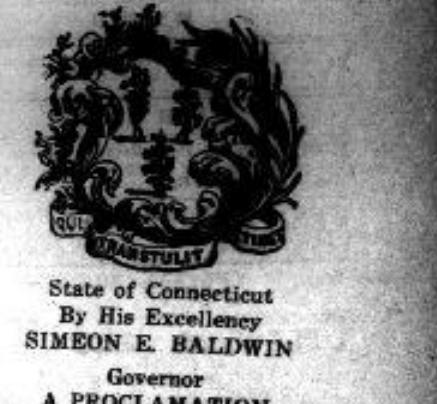

FLAG DAY



Pursuant to the laws of this State, I hereby designate Sunday, the fourteenth day of June next, being the one hundred and thirty-seventh anniversary of the adoption by Congress of the flag of the United States, as

PLAG DAY and remind all those having any share in giving or directing public instruction, exercises, having reference to that event, to be had in the public schools on the school day next preceding, or such other day as the School Visitation Board of Education, or Town School Committee may in any case prescribe. I further recommend that on the day appointed the people of the State display the flag over their homes, and that in every home of God the clergy in leading public worship make such mention of this symbol of American liberty as may best help to impress upon the congregation what great price the winning of that liberty has cost, and what blessings it has secured.

Given under my hand and the seal of the State at the Capitol in Hartford, this nineteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and fourteen, and the two hundred and seventy-seventh (Seal) sixth, and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and thirty-eighth. By His Excellency SIMEON E. BALDWIN, Governor
