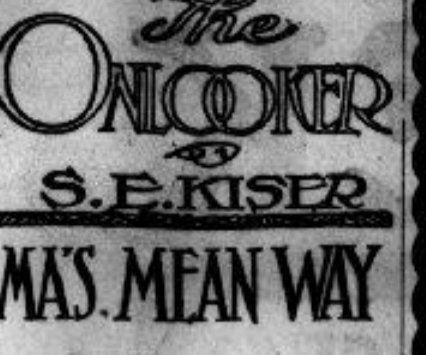

BIG TURNING MOVEMENT CONTINUES

Allies Are Driving in Both Wings of the Germans INVADERS ARE FALLING BY THE THOUSANDS

Each Day Makes It More Difficult For Them to Hold Lines of Communication

London, Oct. 2.—Despite the continued caution of the French official reports, it is clearly evident that the great military movement is steadily forcing the German right wing toward the Belgian boundary.

AT ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION NEXT MONDAY

Australian Ballot Arrangement On Voting Machines. Names Placed in Alphabetical Order. Easily Understood and Not Much Excuse for Mistakes.

Next Monday the voters of this town will have an opportunity to cast their votes by machine, the second time that this privilege has been accorded in a local town election.

For the benefit of those who are not familiar with the machines we will say that the machine voting is very simple. When you take your place in front of the machine turn the curtain lever to the right as far as it will go and leave it there. Then turn pointers down over the names of the different candidates you wish to vote for and leave them down. Move the curtain lever to the left as far as it will go and leave it there—your vote is then recorded by this last movement and you walk from the enclosure.

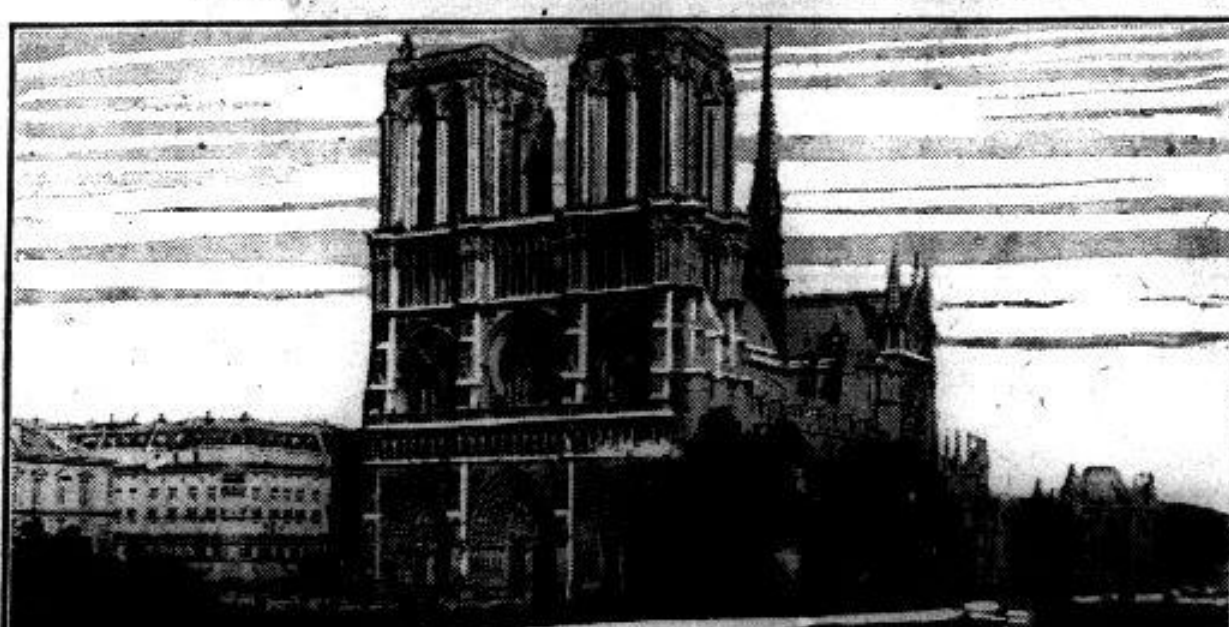

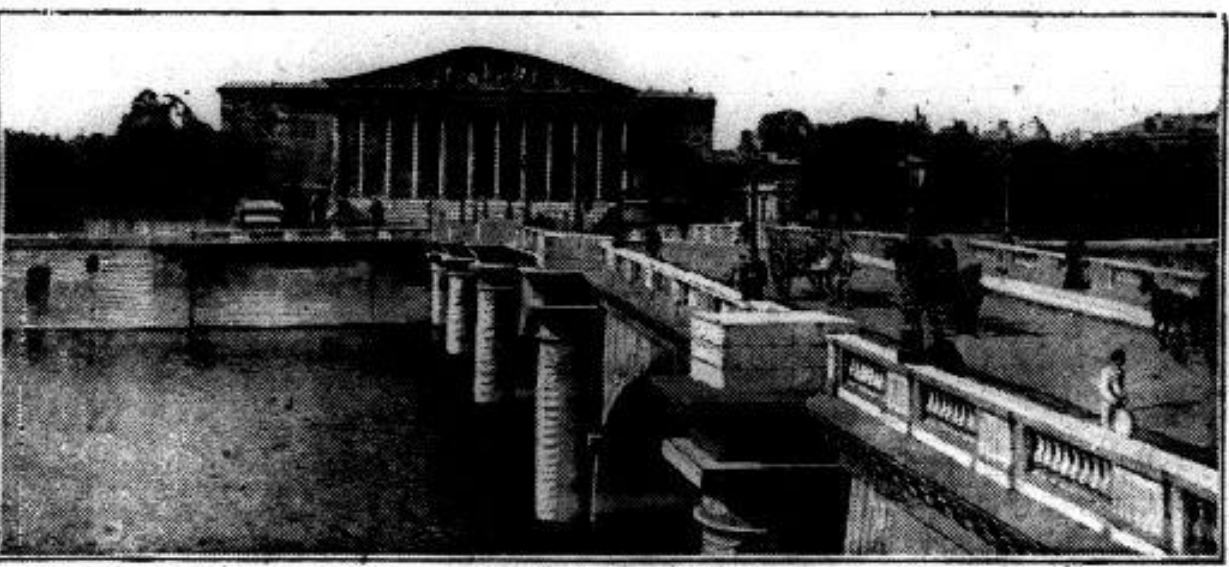

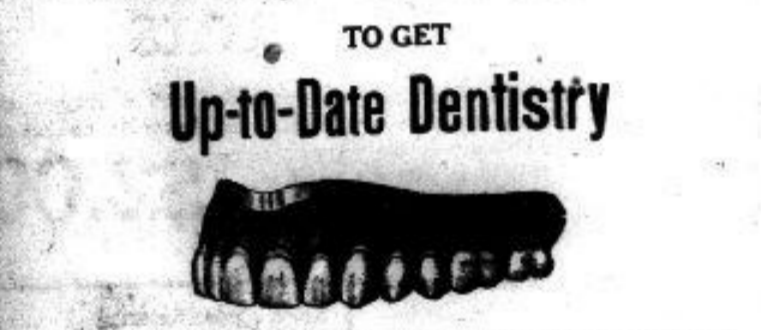
