Arthur Manning Nominated for State Senator

Arthur Manning of South Manchester was the choice of the democratic delegates who met Saturday morning for the Fourth Senatorial District convention. The convention was held in the Democratic Club rooms in Hartford and twenty-six delegates were present. The meeting was called to order by John C. Warner of Wethersfield, chairman of the senatorial district committee. William K. Carroll of East Hartford was chosen chairman and J. J. O'Connor of Wethersfield clerk. John R. Hayes of South Manchester put Mr. Manning's name before the convention as the candidate for the state senate and the nomination was seconded by John C. Warner. There was no other nomination and the secretary was instructed to cast a vote for Mr. Manning. Mr. Manning in accepting the nomination said he had not sought it, but he was gratified for the convention adopted resolutions commending the peace policy of President Wilson and endorsing the democratic administration and the democratic administration of affairs in the state. William K. Carroll of East Hartford, John C. Warner of Wethersfield, J. J. O'Connor of Wethersfield, John R. Hayes of South Manchester, and John C. Warner of Wethersfield were elected a senatorial district committee. Following the convention Mr. Manning entertained the delegates at luncheon at the Hotel Sherman where speeches were made by Constable J. R. Graham, of Hartford, William F. Griswold of Rocky Hill, L.
