THE tango garters illustrated here are made of satin ribbon shirred over rubber elastic.

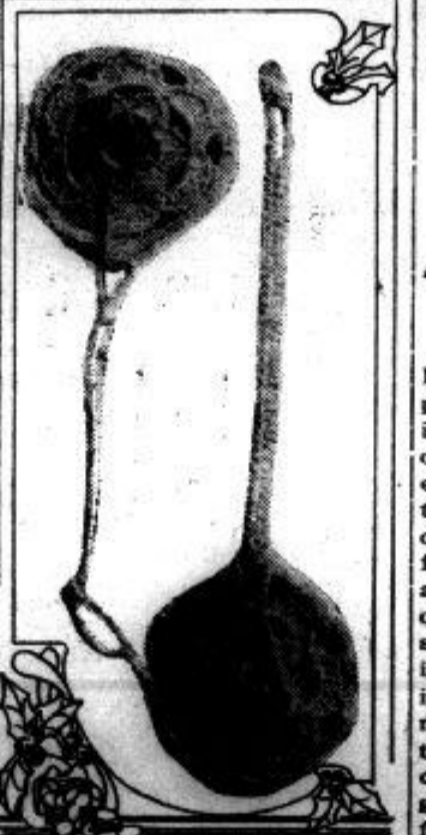
The pair at the top of the illustration are ornamented with French knots in a contrasting shade of silk floss.
