PARCEL POST BRINGS ADDED BUSINESS TO POST-OFFICE CLERKS

Biggest Business Ever Expected This Year—If You Want Parcels Delivered On Or Before Christmas

It is not too early to take up the question of Christmas shopping and the mailing of holiday gifts.

At the Manchester office, extra equipment is being added to meet the holiday demands.

Plan name and address of sender on all mail matter, provided by the word "Four"

Do not send packages, as letter packages are subject to the postal regulations.

The timeliness of gifts of course depends upon their being received on or before Christmas day.

One of the most important points that the public should bear in mind is that parcels should be insured for their value up to \$5 for three cents.

Written inscriptions, such as "Merry Christmas," "Happy New Year," "With Best Wishes," can be permissible additions to parcel post matter.

Parcel post weight limit is fifty pounds in the first and second zones.
