MAIL BOX RULE WILL BE ENFORCED

POSTMASTER GENERAL NOTIFIES POSTMASTER QUISH OF SO. MANCHESTER Two Sizes Officially Designated and Have Been Adopted—Dimensions Given and General Details As To Manufacture and Sale of Boxes.

Postmaster Thomas J. Quish received notification from the office of the postmaster general that the rule of the department, made last November, regulating the size and design of all mail boxes on rural and star routes, will be enforced from July 1, 1916, the beginning of the fiscal year.

The instructions from Washington are, in part, as follows: In accordance with the postmaster general's order No. 927, dated November 10, 1915, all mail boxes erected on rural and star routes on and after July 1, 1916, must conform to the department's specifications in every respect and be officially approved.

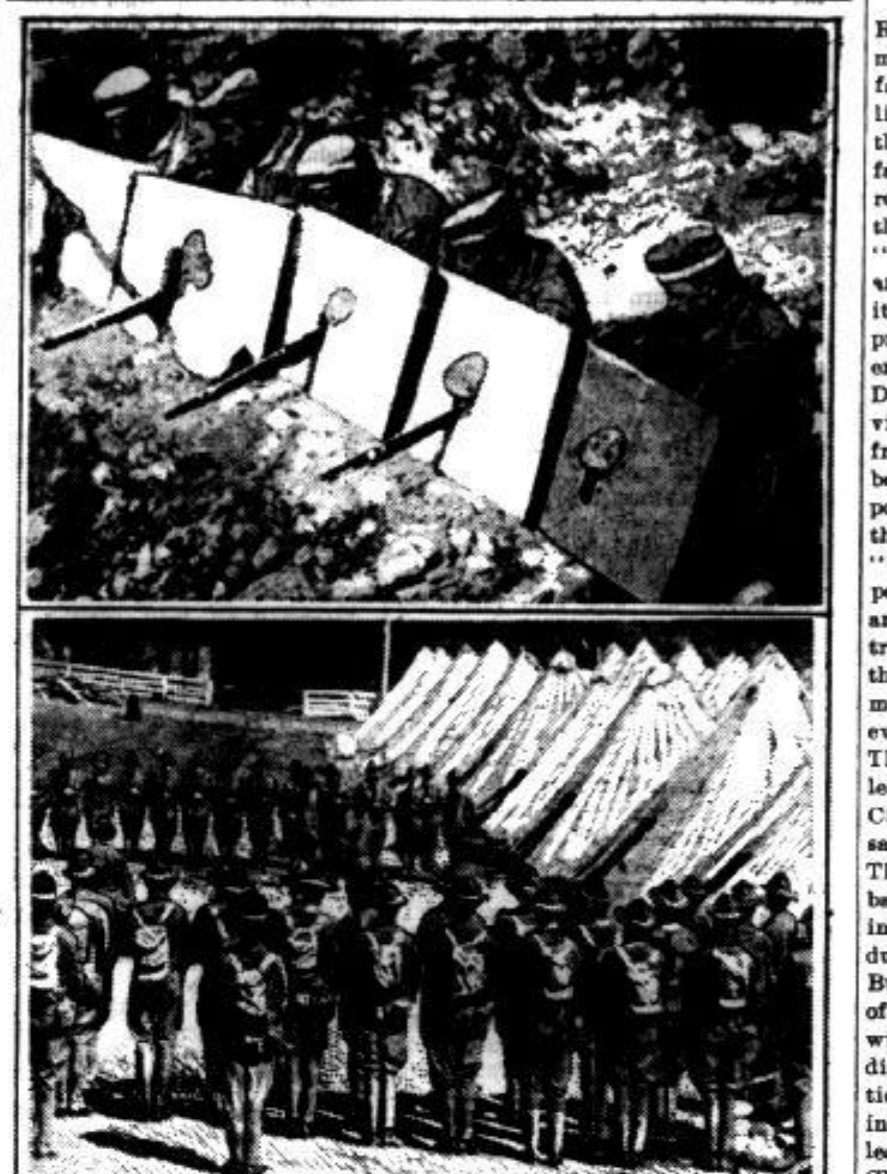
VII.—The Nation Should Have One Army

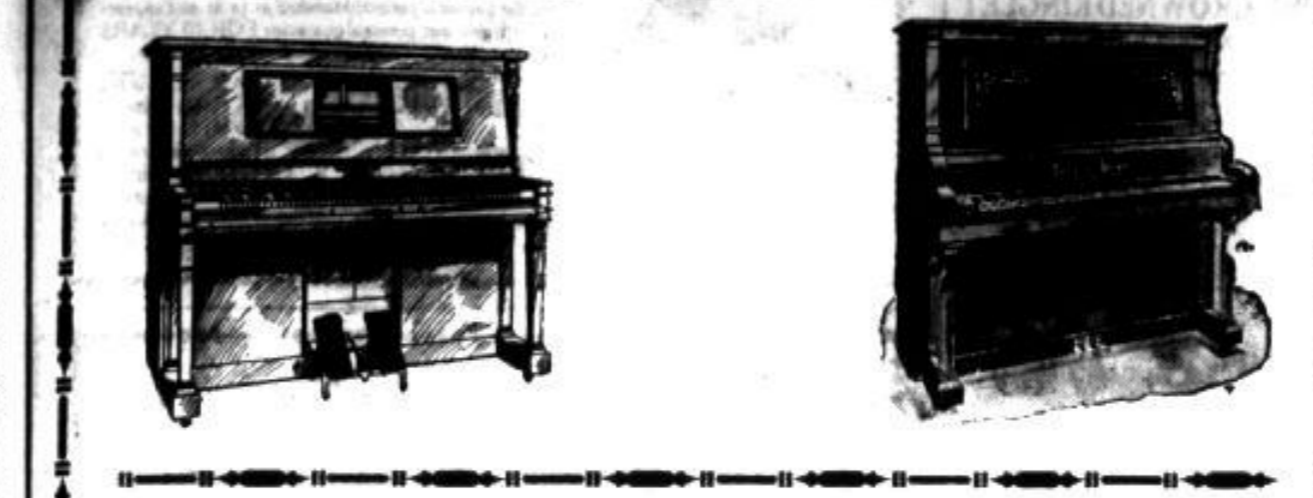
