The subject of compulsory military training is receiving widespread attention at present and the following interesting discussion of the proposition is taken from The Spokesman-Review of Spokane, Washington. We quote:

Universal obligatory physical and military training of the country's youth would give the nation three distinct benefits that are needed.

1. Through preparedness—a great reserve of citizen soldiers which would tend powerfully to restrain foreign aggression and attack.

2. Its disciplinary influence alone would be worth the cost and effort. Morally the nation would be uplifted, for young men receiving the training would become better men, better heads of families, better citizens.

3. The physical betterment of the race alone would be worth many times the cost. Consider the value to the individual of those who are rejected are then given an opportunity to overcome their defects and take another examination a year later.

The strength of the principle of universal obligatory training springs from the fact that it carries a double and reciprocal obligation—the obligation of the individual to defend the state, and the obligation of the state to foster the physical and moral welfare of the individual.
