### FATHER MAGNELL SPOKE ON MEXICO

#### BEFORE HOLY NAME SOCIETY AT FORESTERS HALL LAST MONDAY EVENING

Some Account of Recent Observations While Serving as Chaplain to Connecticut Militia at Nogales, Arizona—Favors Military Training in Schools.

It is anything but a sincere. He said the Connecticut boys are not adapted for that sort of life. Their early training militated against it. They had been brought up to commercial, manufacturing and mercantile pursuits in the main and had not been graduated from the school of the pick and shovel. Despite these facts they had been brought up to do so. He said that by doing so the rising generation would be taught obedience to law and respect for property constituted authority. They would also be given a course of training that would make stronger, more active and more alert men generally and that should it ever become necessary for them to respond to their country's call for military duty they would at least have some knowledge of the rudimentary requirements of soldier life and would thus be the better fitted to defend the flag and maintain the supremacy of the United States against any invading foe.
