READER EXEMPTIONS FOR FARMERS

The committee of Food Supply of the State Council of Defense, yesterday made recommendations as follows in regard to exemption for agricultural labor. They asked that three classes receive consideration in this connection.

First: Men with a technical education capable of supervising agricultural projects, including boys farm labor camps, and managers of farms conducted on a commercial basis.

Second: Trained veterinarians and butcher makers (meat) who are familiar with pasteurizing, bottling, and care of milk in general and herdsmen having a knowledge of feeding.

This action was taken by the committee of Food Supply in response to requests from W. J. Spillman, Chief of the Food Administration, and the United States Department of Agriculture, and from Herbert Knox Smith, Chairman of the committee on man power and labor of the Connecticut State Council of Defense.

The department of farm management which is handling the question of farm labor during the present crisis has called upon to make recommendations to the War Department in regard to exemptions of agricultural workers and, in order to do so intelligently, is soliciting the cooperation of the Connecticut State Council of Defense in the various states.

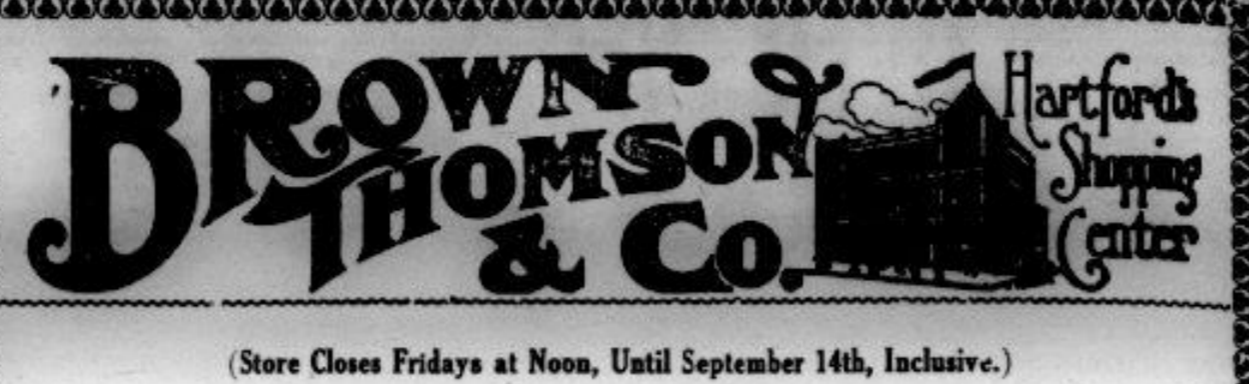

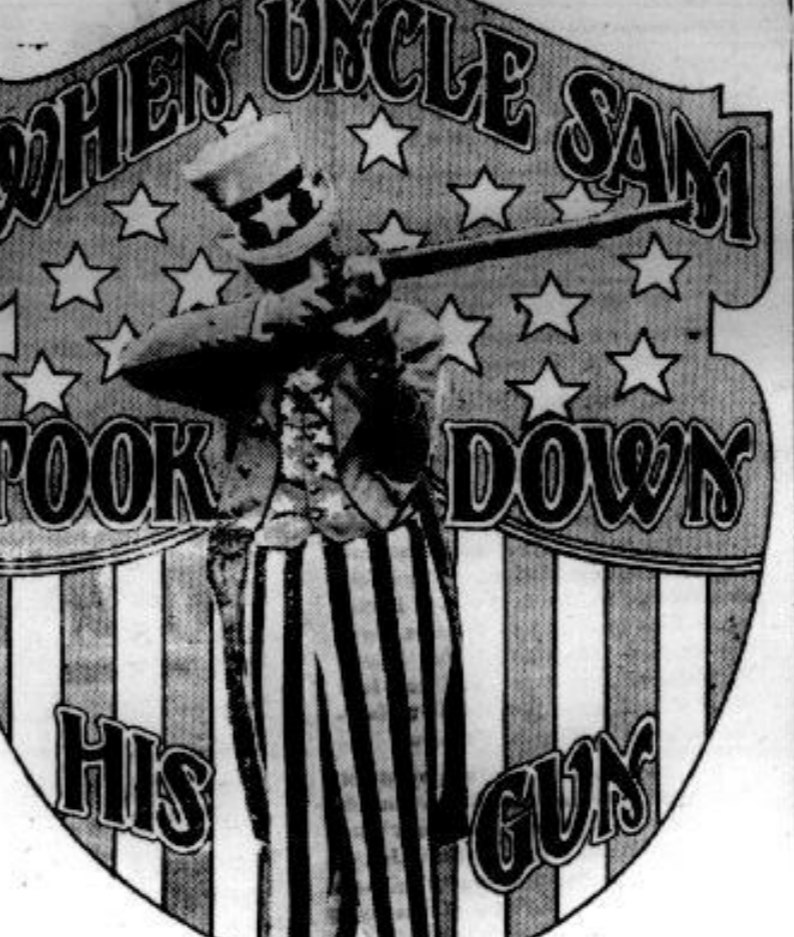
