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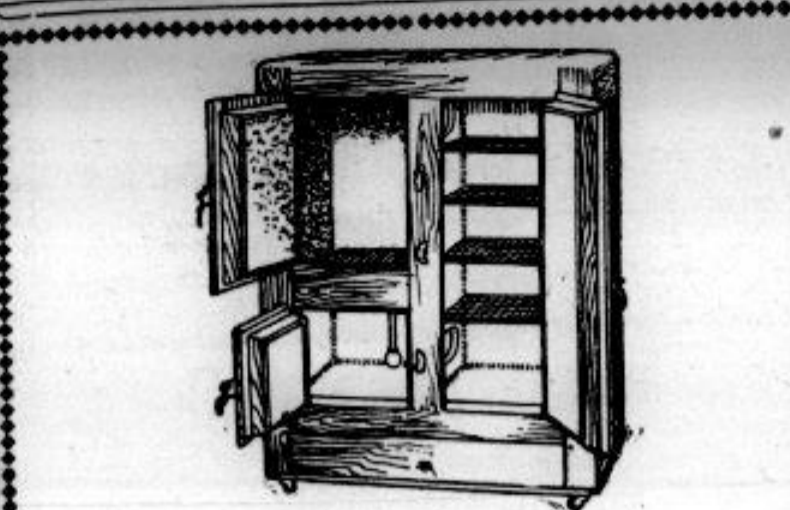

Watch Milk Inspectors Report

The milk inspectors report for the month of August will be found in the advertising columns of The News to-day. During hot weather it is especially desirable that pure milk be supplied, and this matter is well worthy of the closest attention of all housekeepers. Many summer troubles are likely to arise if impure milk is permitted to be used in the family. Watch for this and take advantage of the protection which the Board of Health is giving you by means of the most up-to-date inspection and its publication in the newspapers. Scientific men make the examinations of the samples of milk picked up and shipped to them by Milk Inspector John D. Henderson and the published list is absolutely fair, impartial and reliable.

INFORMATION WANTED POTATO ACREAGE

In order to arrive at an intelligent understanding of the probable potato crop of the state the Committee of Food Supply of the State Council of Defense is taking steps to ascertain the potato acreage in Connecticut. In each town a special representative is being appointed to report the acreage for his town, and this representative is given certain powers as seem helpful in arriving at accurate conclusions in regard to the crop. This action is in anticipation of the needs of the war and is being taken by the Federal food commission with which the committee of food supply is co-operating fully. It was apparent at a meeting in Boston last week that to secure information in regard to the acreage only at a later date the condition of the crop will be investigated. It is planned to complete this survey August 1.

NEW HAVEN ORDERS ELECTRIC ENGINES

To obtain maximum service in the emergency cases between New Haven and New York, the "New Haven" road has placed orders for five motor electric engines which will be capable of drawing twelve laden passenger coaches each. An engine will weigh 180 tons and be able to develop seventy miles an hour. Fifty development engines will be ordered. Each engine will be built to run on either of four systems, the "New Haven" the New York Central, the New York connecting road over Hell Gate Bridge, and the Pennsylvania. Three systems of electrical propulsion are represented.

“OVER THERE” The Thrill and the Hell of the Trenches, Described by an American Boy.

Sergeant Alexander McClintock of Lexington, Ky., and the Canadian Army Has Greeting Tale That Every American Will Read. For He Tells the Facts—Unadorned.

No. 3, “Over the Top and Give ‘Em Hell!”

By Sergeant Alexander McClintock, D. C. M., 5th Overseas Battalion, Canadian Guards.

AS we climbed out of the shelter of our trenches for my first—adventure in No Man's Land the word was passed.

“Over the top and give ‘em hell!” This is the British Tommy's battle cry as he charges the enemy. It has often sounded up and down those long lines in western France as the British, Canadian and Australian soldiers go on to the front.

“Over the top and give ‘em hell!” other than the machine gun bullets began to drop men almost immediately.

There were two things which made it possible for our routing party to get started across No Man's Land.

We were crawling about on all fours just under the edge of the German trench and taking what shelter we could in shell holes.

“Up” is not just a suitable term. We were crawling about on all fours just under the edge of the German trench and taking what shelter we could in shell holes.

We found them lining up the survivors of our party for a roll call. That showed us more missing than Major Lewis, formerly of the Montreal Staff, called for volunteers to go.

The fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth in line were severely wounded. They were to take the place of those who had first four who might become casualties.

Next, according to the queer psychology of battle, I began to lose my nerve. I was nearly done.
