

CROWN FOR SALE

Emblem of Hungarian Monarchy Said to Be on Market.

By Far the Oldest Existing Regalia in Europe, and Said to Good Authority to Date Back 1,000 Years.

According to a recent dispatch from Budapest, the government has offered to sell for the sum of 100,000 Swiss francs, normally about \$100,000, the famous crown of Hungary known as the crown of St. Stephen. It is a strange relic which has played this, the most ancient and revered crown in all Europe, for a possible object of a commercial transaction, and if the offer is really a bona fide one, there are doubtless a good many collectors of ancient and curious relics, both in the United States and Europe, not to mention those who are interested in the history of this famous crown. TREES IN DESERT OF SAHARA

Besides the Palm, There is Said to Be Many Varieties, Also Foreign Plants and Shrubs.

Besides the palm tree, which requires rather a large sheet of water, various other sorts of trees are found in the Sahara, some from numerous shrubs and tamarisks, principally the frank tree and the olive, a variety of the tamarisk. In the southern Sahara the thorned Egyptian palm is found; it does not bear fruit, but the trunk and branches serve various purposes. The apricot is also found in some of the most arid regions of the Sahara, but it is not a native tree.

The Sahara contains a number of foreign plants and shrubs. It was on these that the famous pastures of the desert were based, and that often the 1,000 or 1,500 camels of the caravan were fed on the produce of the desert. It is not for the first time that the Sahara has been the scene of a botanical expedition and its preliminary observations and reports are being published.
