Trunk Line Officials Recognize Educational Value of Big Exposition

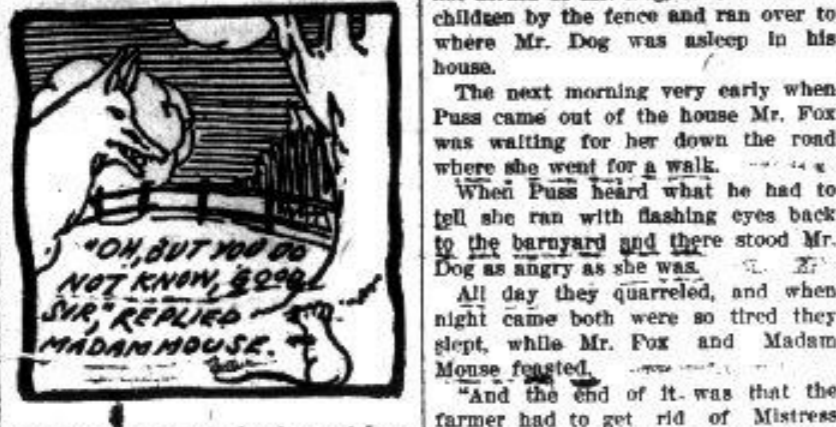

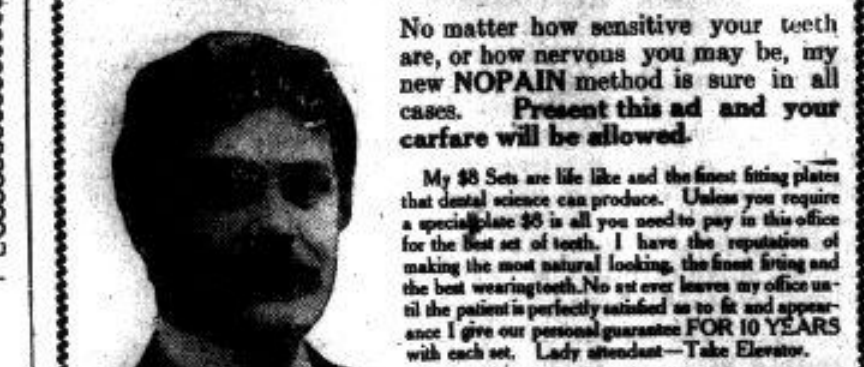
