A HERO OF LEGEND

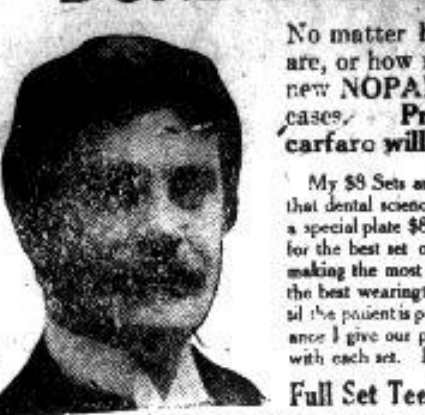
