OLD INDIAN RACE

"Red Paint Problem" Is Interesting Archeologists.

Explorations in the State of Maine Have So Far Been Inconclusive, But Will Go On...

Since the recent donation to the state of Maine of a number of bones of relief, 3,500 pieces, there has been a renewed interest in the explorations in Maine in connection with the so-called Red Paint Indians.

Several of the earlier explorations were around the town of Arundel in Hancock county. Ernest O. Sugden, the town clerk, has long been interested in Indian exploration work, and he himself developed into quite an authority on the subject.

Mr. Sugden's curiosity in Indian archeological matters led him, in 1912, when C. C. Willoughby of the Penobscot National Park, St. Johns, was on the scene, to explore the area known as the Red Paint Indian site, near the mouth of the Penobscot river.

From the shores of the lake, as the first look down upon it, the waters were saturated with boiling water. But, in this case, it was merely the steam from the eruptive activity of the volcano.

In these graves are found peculiar mugs, hatchet blades, flint spear points, long pendants, arrowheads and iron pyrites, and occasionally chipped arrowheads, but the latter are not frequently found.

A. H. Bridges of Waterville, who has long been interested in archeological matters, called the attention of Gen. Miliken not long ago to evidences of the former existence of the Red Paint Indians in certain burial grounds in Waterville and Winslow.

LAKE OF IMMENSE DEPTH

Atitlan, in Guatemala, Is One of the World's Most Remarkable Bodies of Water

Below the cities with their public squares and white churches, fields of yellow grain like golden patches of light in the crystal-clear atmosphere of the Guatemala highlands, high dark masses of forest and beyond, extending their thousands of spurs and flanks, rose the prodigious Cordilleras.

Lake Atitlan, 36 miles long and 12 miles wide, is a remarkable body of water.

Its surface is 5,000 feet below the level of the sea.
