As indicated in our last letter, the stock market has not made any average advance and in fact Saturday showed considerable weakness.

The market is still in a state of uncertainty, with conditions prevailing in Germany.

Something may be expected in the way of a settlement by the coal strike, now that the president has returned.

It will not be on a basis which will oblige the public to pay as it too often the case. Outside of a few cases of intimidation, chiefly in Chicago and the Southwest, the railroad strike enters its second week without inconveniencing the public noticeably.

We believe this strike is against public opinion and that the railroad if left to their own efforts and given proper police protection, can take care of the situation.

Money has ruled in fairly good supply, call money being a little stiffer at 4% and 4 1/2 time money unchanged.

The gradual increase in industrial activities has brought an increased demand for money and resulted in a transfer of funds from the east to New York to the interior.
