by carried lot from this place in another indication of the great changes which have taken place in port office work during the past few years. Presently the postal worker spent his time on letter mail, newspapers and periodicals, stamp selling and money order work. The organization was formed for a light traffic, but with the advent of the steady movement of mail in its original sense—letters and printed matter. But now all this is changed. Besides the movement of the letter and periodical mail, the postal workers have a multitude of duties. Each morning mail unloads parcels enough to transform the post office into an express office. These packages vary from a box of cigars or a jar of jam to a bushel of potatoes or a crate of live chicks, and all have to be delivered through parcel carrier or through the local box office. Each outgoing mail carries truckloads of parcel post, all of which has to be routed and packed in the dispatching office.

Banking Features
The postal savings division and the government treasury savings certificates business constitute an important financial division in the post office. The issuing and cashing of certificates, the opening of new accounts, and the securing of the transactions to the government keep the postal workers constantly busy. And then there are almost daily changes with which the postal employees are familiar, varying from new rates for certificates and new rates of interest to the finger-printing of the postal savings depositors.

Work is Intricate.
The money order conversion table for computing the value of foreign money orders is constantly changing. Manchester, with its large foreign population, has extensive foreign money order business. There are also numerous intricate conditions for shipping goods to foreign countries, including the declarations for the customs service, invoices, and receipts. These are on the list of articles reviewed on shipment.

On the whole, the postal workers find that their duties consist of really more than stamp selling and letter-sorting. Nevertheless, the changes among them in Manchester at the only English speaking school in the city. The English language school is a very interesting one. STATE COPS WATCH AUTO HEADLIGHTS

Violators Will Be Haled Into Court.

Supervisor Robert T. Hurley of the state police has notified the motor vehicle department that 1,149 arrests will be made during the past four months, or about 46 per cent were for violations of the motor vehicle laws; 59 were arrested because of infractions of the headlight law.

Following a consultation yesterday with Commissioner of Motor Vehicles Robbin B. Stochel, a general order was sent out by Superintendent Hurley to each state police station in the state instructing the commanding officer to put patrol on the roads from 6:30 to 11 p. m. with special orders to give full attention to headlights.

It is shown by records of the department that several of the motor vehicle counts reported during the summer months were due to the improper headlights. In many cases, the glare from illegal lamps blinded the operators of automobiles that were wrecked, and in others, the operator of a car was confused by the fact that an approaching car was equipped with but one headlight being in operation. This practice is unusually dangerous at this time of the year when driving at night is made more difficult by fog.

The motor vehicle department has directed the attention of state policemen to the section of the general motor vehicle law which prohibits the use of spotlights when an approaching motor vehicle is in sight, except when projecting its rays directly on the ground at a distance of not more than sixty feet in front of the vehicle, and to the right of the axis or center of such motor vehicle.
