330 RESCUED WHEN LINER SINKS IN RIVER

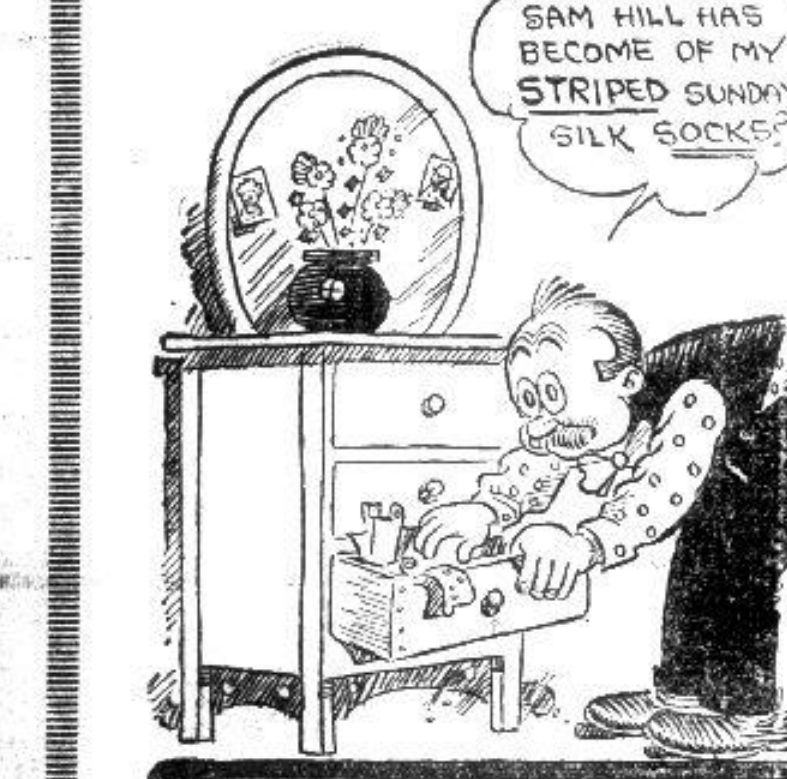
