

BEIJING HAS PROPOSED PLAN WHICH WILL AID FRANCE IN COLLECTING GERMAN DEBT

Railroads to Be Exploited and Foreign Exchanges Sold—This With Profit From German Coal and Several Monopolies Should Bring in About \$588,000,000 Annually

Paris, May 29.—Belgium has proposed a reparations plan to France by which 2,400,000,000 gold marks (about \$5,880,000,000) will be collected annually from the Inter-Allied reparations commission, it being estimated that 1,900,000,000 gold marks could be realized annually in this way.

1. Germany balance her budget by selling her foreign exchanges. 2. German railroads be exploited internationally for the benefit of the Inter-Allied reparations commission, it being estimated that 1,900,000,000 gold marks could be realized annually in this way.

3. All profits from German coal mines to be turned over to the reparations fund, experts claiming that this would bring in 100,000,000 gold marks yearly. 4. Reparations commission would take a quarter of the stock in all German corporations obtaining the Inter-Allied reparations.

5. Reparations commission would take over German government monopolies upon tobacco, alcohol and sugar. 6. Abolish the blockade and permit Germans themselves to exploit the Rhine and Ruhr for the benefit of the reparations account.

French and Belgian troops would remain in the Ruhr, until only a quarter of the reparations plan, but only as a guarantee of the reparations plan, with the German government.

Premier Poincaré will go to Brussels next week for a conference. The Belgian offer will then be discussed. It is understood many French economic experts will accompany the premier.

The sum of 2,400,000,000 gold marks represents the minimum that would be obtained yearly from Germany under the Belgian plan. This does not include the sums expected from the exploitation of the Ruhr upon tobacco, alcohol, sugar and from other sources.

SEEK LAIR OF BANDITS WITH 2 AIRPLANES

Military Leaders Fear Shanting Brigands Will Retreat Further Into Mountain Retreats—American Prisoners Suffer From Vermin and Cold.

Shanghai, May 29.—Two Chinese army airplanes are kept flying over the mountains near Pao-Zuku to spy upon the movements of the Shanting bandits who seized a number of foreign prisoners, including American General Cole referred in the first hearing on the Manchester Army bill before the legislative committee on military affairs.

While the Chinese army drifted last night and forth over the mountains with observers watching all the trails, the party between the provincial officials and brigand leaders has continued, but without result.

Peking has sent a telegram to the Military Governor of Shantung Province saying he expects to obtain the release of the captives within ten days.

L. C. Solomon, one of the American prisoners, wrote from the mountain camp that the chief commandment of the Americans is playing mahjong with the Chinese game, with the bandit chief.

None of the Americans has been killed but they are suffering from vermin and cold.
