UNCLE SAM BEGINS TODAY PAYING THREE BILLIONS

During New Fiscal Year Treasury Will Be Handing Out Cash at Rate of \$8,500,000 Each Day—Budget Bureau's Program Forbids Any Haphazard Payments However—Receipts and Disbursements Figured in Terms of Average Dollar.

Washington, July 2.—Uncle Sam started today, the beginning of the new fiscal year with a little over three billion dollars to spend during the next twelve months.

No Haphazard Payments. The Treasury will not spend a cent until the amount appropriated by Congress for the next year is available.

The Treasury begins the new fiscal year with a balance of \$3,500,000,000, the result of unexpected increases in Internal and Customs receipts.

Approximately two thirds of the total year's expenditures will be for the National Defense, the largest slice—39 cents, or 25 percent of the total.
