BRITAIN TO BE IN RUNNING AT 1924 OLYMPIC

The marks established in several of the events will, as the British say, take a lot of beating. Two outstanding performances were that of E. H. Liddell, the Scottish champion, who set a new British record for the 100-yard dash and stepped the century in less than 16 seconds, and that of J. H.
