5,000 MILES FOR \$500
California Reporter on a Tramp
Has Waged Half Won and is
Earning It.

(New York Times)
Fred Taylor, 20, a young man arrived in New York yesterday, completing for a wager of \$500, the first lap of a walk from Los Angeles and back. He left his home at 1,342 Figueroa St., Los Angeles, on June 3 and has until Nov. 1 to accomplish his return.

Taylor came into the office of The Times yesterday to ask for proof that he had reached New York. He had been organized by Assistant Manager O'Malley of the Los Angeles Associated Press Bureau, and that stakes were held by Leon Goodman, a reporter for the Los Angeles Times and the Player, whose home is at Beverly Hills, Hollywood.

"The wager came about this way," said Taylor. "I was sitting talking with O'Malley and a number of other men. O'Malley said, 'You fellows are a lazy lot, you never take any exercise.' I told O'Malley we was making and that for half a cent I could get him to bet me I could walk from New York to Los Angeles and back again." O'Malley said, "I bet you \$500 you don't." I staggered along for 15 minutes with my mouth, eyes, hair and nostrils getting full of sand every moment. When I thought I could stand it no longer I crawled under a broken-down wagon. Half-blinded I crawled into the leeside of the storm and buried my face in my coat. The storm lasted fully an hour and I was so exhausted I could not see properly for several hours. I flagged girt for a month."

The amount of stolen property during 1922 was greatest by approximately \$250,000 than in 1921.

Cause of burglary in 1922 were 461 less than in the previous year, and arrests for this offense consequently fell off.
