Dempsey missed a left and Firpo dived a right into his body, sending him to his knees. Dempsey floored Firpo with a left hook to the chin but he was up after taking a count. When he got up, Dempsey sent him to the floor with a second time with a hard right but he did not take a count. Dempsey knocked him over for the third time. When he got up Jack chased him to the center, knocking him down a second time. After being floored for the fourth time Firpo knocked Dempsey through the ropes and landed a couple of punches. Firpo pounded Dempsey on the jaw with a sledge hammer right, bringing the blood from his mouth. Firpo also landed when he went to his corner.
