FORD'S ENDORSEMENT OF COOLIDGE SATISFIES ALL

President's Backers Jubilant While Democrats Could Not Feel More Pleased — Johnson and La Follette Following Fail to Concede Automobile Man's Big Strength Will Be Turned Over to Any One Candidate

Washington, Dec. 20.—Henry Ford has played Santa Claus to the political factions and leaders of all parties by his unqualified endorsement of President Coolidge for re-nomination and election in 1924, according to expressions of opinion heard today in the wake of the Detroit's epochal announcement.

Coolidge Backers Jubilant
Friends of President Coolidge were jubilant. They pointed out that Ford's announcement not only removes a possible opponent for the Republican nomination but that it also will have a powerful effect on the throwing of the so-called "Ford following" into the Coolidge ranks.

BRITAIN WILLING TO ENTER AIR CONFERENCE

London, Dec. 20.—Great Britain is willing to participate in an international conference for air navigation and air traffic, according to a statement issued by the Foreign Office officials today.

It was pointed out that Ramsay MacDonald, leader of the Labour party, may succeed Stanley Baldwin as premier and MacDonald is known to be in sympathy with any movement for disarmament.

So far the Foreign Office has not received any definite information as to the proposed conference, which was conveyed in press dispatches from Washington.

It was reported in official circles that unofficial negotiations are in progress between representatives of Great Britain and the United States, and that the British government is also ready to recognize the Moscow government.

Whether the British government is convinced that MacDonald would grant early recognition to the Soviet government if he comes into power as British premier, is not known.
