VERA CRUZ TO FALL IN FORTNIGHT SAYS OBREGON

MEXICAN PRESIDENT REPORTS CAPTURE OF 2,000 REVOLU- TIONARIES—FIVE DAY BATTLE BEING WAGED FOR SANTA LUCRESCIA WITH ODDS IN FA- VOR OF REBELS IS INSUR- GENT'S REPORT

WASHINGTON, Dec. 26.—The Mexi-
can bootlegger chief int'nt said to
capture the names of 1,500 captives
and rebels, generalissimo of the Revolu-
tionary forces, reported today.

Washington has been in the pos-
ition for a week officially int'nt

as "missing in action" today.

Two thousand revolutionaries
were captured in recent fighting at
Puerto Vallarta, Mexico.
