

We hear of bank capital, surplus and stockholders. What BANK CAPITAL-The money necessary to engage in the business of rendering bank-

ing services to the community. SURPLUS-A part of a bank's earnings not reserved for possible losses or to expand activities as needed by growing business. CAPITAL AND SURPLUS-Protection to depositors, because if trouble arises depositors must be paid in full out of these funds if necessary before stockholders are paid anything.

J. H. Puelloher BANK STOCKHOLDER=Anyone able and willing to buy stock in a bank and to assume the risk of the business. A share of stock represents a fraction of ownership in the whole, and with ownership go responsibilities and liabilities. In smaller communities these who usually organize banks interest successful farm-ers, successful merchants and successful manufacturers because of the influence they bring.

DOUBLE LIABILITY-The obligation under the law that rests on a bank stockholder, in case his bank fails and the assets are not enough to pay depositors, to pay an amount equal to his bank stock, in addition to losing his original investment.

This is not the case in corporations other than banks. Example: If a man owned \$1,000 in bank stock and the bank failed, and after the assets had been used, the bank still owed money to depositors, the stockholders would be required to pay up to another \$1,000 if necessary to meet the

Thus it is seen that bank capital and bank stockholders perform real economic services.


