"In combination with alfalfa and grain, it balances the ration, acts as a laxative and prevents the danger of over-feeding protein. Without soft feed, especially during the stable feeding in the Winter, protein diet has a danger of accumulating fat around the milk-producing vessels of the animal and thus reducing production-a danger that scientific agriculturalists agree is entirely climi-nated by feeding sugar beet pulp.
