

London, May 27.—One of the longest and most remarkable journeys ever undertaken to perform a surgical operation has just been completed by P. Lockart-Mummary, famous English cancer specialist and chairman of the British Empire Cancer Campaign to wipe out cancer.

He has just returned from the 15,000-mile distant city of Khatmandu, in India, one of the few forbidden cities to the world, to where he was called to perform an operation on the 19-year-old Maharajah of Nepal in his wonderful palace there.

Strangers are only allowed in Khatmandu on the express invitation of the Maharajah and can only leave with his permission. Lockart-Mummary is perhaps the first stranger to have entered its gates in this way, and he has brought back new vivid impressions of the journey, the city and its inhabitants to the Maharajah.

When Lockart-Mummary and his assistants arrived at the nearest railhead they were met by the Maharajah's representatives with an automobile and three huge elephants, the former for the conveyance of the passengers and the latter for the baggage.

Lockart-Mummary describes the journey through the jungle to Khatmandu as "amazing," the passengers being thrown about the automobile during the first day's journey along a crooked path. Armed guards accompanied the party until the Himalayas had been crossed and the Maharajah's territory was reached.

At the bottom of the Himalayas the regal carriages awaited them, and they were driven to the palace, a large palace standing in its own grounds in appearance like an old English country house.

Describing the Maharajah, Lockart-Mummary says he was always extremely astir and wearing wonderful jewels which he carried on his neck. A noticeable jewel was his one carrying an enormous ruby. His five-year-old daughter was always present with him and she was observed one day in the garden ground leading a monkey.

The Maharajah's operation is a desperate to have been successful.
