Charge will be made for all water measured by each meter including all that may have been wasted through leaky fixtures or otherwise. Consumers are urgently requested to prevent all such wastage that their charges for water may not be excessive.

Bills will be rendered quarterly for each previous three months' service and are due and payable (without discount for cash) within fifteen (15) days from date of bill. Bills not paid within thirty (30) days will be subject to interest.

Failure to pay bills as aforesaid will subject the delinquent customer or consumer to a suspension of the water service until all indebtedness to the Company has been satisfactorily adjusted.

Bills payable for service for quarter ending July 1st, 1924 will be rendered at the old rates and subject to the usual 10% discount for prompt payment.

Bills are to be paid only by check sent by mail, or by cash or check left at the Company's Office in Cheney Brothers' Office Building at 146 Hartford Road, or at the Company's Office at 80 South Main Street, South Manchester.

The South Manchester Water Company is announcing a new schedule of rates, the greatest increase in the cost of all labor, materials and taxes which have been levied by the State, and the increased cost of the water supply.
