Transfer in Ownership Farr Brothers on Main Street, But Flower Ven- ture Still Remains in Hands of Family.

A Main street business change of much interest is announced in the sale by Joseph J. Farr of the mainly manufacturing business to- gether with the ice cream, soda and fruit store on Main street to his brother, Nicholas J. Farr. The business has been conducted by Joseph J. Farr for the past two years having bought it from his father, Felix Farr.

Nicholas J. Farr the new owner has been brought up in the candy and fruit business so to speak and knows it thoroughly. When his brother Joseph Farr entered the service in 1917, afterwards going overseas, the new owner was in charge assisted by his father. Dr. James Farr was also in the ser- vice at that time. Joseph Farr has not announced his plans for the future but says that he intends to take his time and look around be- fore making any definite move.

The name of Farr Brothers and the fruit and ice cream business have been synonymous in South Manchester for the past thirty years. Felix and James Farr, two brothers came to this place and started a candy manufacturing business in a small way. Their place being the first of the kind in South Manchester. They were located in a store near where the present Hoon and Hain building is located. They also conducted a candy business in the 4th of July market on Main street and were consistently successful in all the times the Watkins business was operated some years ago.
