## A History of the Somanhis

The first issue of the Somanhis was printed "way back" in 1916 at the old South Manchester High School with the assistance of Miss Fanny Rexford, who later became Mrs. Sidney Wheaton. The previous year found the newly established debating club discussing as its first issue - "Resolved: M.H.S. Should Have a School Publication". The debate was won by the supporters of the resolution and shortly thereafter a contest was held to determine a name for the new publication. Miss Gladys Keith won the contest with her entry of "Somanhis", a name derived from the first letters of the school's name. Elected as the first editor was Ronald Ferguson, who, in later life was closely associated with the Manchester Herald.
The "Somanhis Events", as it was then called, was a thin news and literary magazine which was published several times a year. The year

1933 marked the birth of the SOMANHIS as a yearbook independent of the literary magazine, and the yearbook came under the direction of a new adviser, Miss Ione Fellows. Over the years, the M.H.S. annual has had various themes ranging from friendship and patriotism in the war years to a tribute to our new states, Alaska and Hawaii, in 1961. Many times we hear the expression "Don't judge a book by its cover", but in the case of the SOMANHIS, the cover often expresses the theme of the book or a significant event of that year. With an increase in the graduating classes from 218 seniors in 1933 to 671 seniors graduating in 1961, the yearbook has also increased in size correspondingly.

After twenty-eight years of devoted service in producing the SOMANHIS, Miss Ione Fellows handed over the advisership of the annual to Mr. Jay R. Stager in 1962.

We of the Somanhis staff wish to express our deepest appreciation to Miss Ione Fellows who has guided the production of the yearbook for twenty-eight years. She has devoted much time and energy to Somanhis, and through her ability and dedication to it, she has not only helped our yearbook to improve each year, but has also contributed greatly to the successful growth of the Connecticut Scholastic Press Association. We sincerely thank her for a job welldone!

The athletes of MHS engaged in another fine season of varsity sports. In addition to the customary varsity teams, a wrestling team was established under the direction of Mr. Alibrio. While commending the outstanding accomplishments of the varsity players, one can not overlook the development of the junior varsity players. In the future we look forward to seeing the Papooses carry on the fine tradition of the MHS Indians.

The Varsity Cross Country Team was captained by John Salcius this year. The team ended the season with a commendable record of 8 wins, 4 losses, and 1 tie, attaining second place in the CCIL. The team also placed sixth in the state meet after taking the laurels in the CCIL Field Day.

The Varsity Football Team had two new coaches this year, Mr. Alibrio and Mr . Early. The team ended the season with a record of 2 wins, 6 losses, and 1 tie. The Indians placed sixth in the CCIL. Co-Captains for the 1961 1962 season were Tony Alibrio and Dave Malausky.

Mr. Danielson's Varsity Soccer Team proved to be one of the finest teams. During the regular season the team chalked up a record of 9 wins, 2 losses, and 1 tie. The team, which at the beginning of the season was not considered a great threat by the other coaches, ended the year by taking the CCIL championship in a tie with Hall. In the state tournament Brian McMahon High School was defeated by a margin of 3 to 0 . Glastonbury

suffered defeat 3 to 2 in an overtime. The Indians reached the finals with Greenwich but lost in an overtime by a score of 2 to 1. With Bud Feshler and Mike Churilla as Co-Captains, the MHS Soccer Team was a formidable opponent for every team it met.

Football was not the only sport that had a new coaching staff this year. Mr. Costa and Mr. Moriarty are the new coaches of the J.V. Basketball Team, and Mr. Hyde is the new coach of the Varsity Basketball Team. In his first year as mentor, the team won 8 games and lost 8 games, placing fourth in the CCIL. Since the team consisted almost entirely of juniors, the Indian cagers were not expected to place so high in the final CCIL Standings. Co-Captains for the 1961-1962 season were Bill Andrulot and Paul Quey.

Mr. Sollanek's Swimming Team had a very fine season this year. The Indian Tankers lost only to Crosby High School and defeated all their CCIL Rivals and so placed first in the CCIL. Captain of this year's fine team was Jim Hunter.
