





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THE 1963 SOMANHIS . . . a priceless possession.

PURPOSE

The Student Council acts as the voice between the students and administration. It works to regulate the social activities of the student body and to maintain a high morale among the students.

ORGANIZATION

The Council is composed of homeroom representatives and alternates from each senior high school class. Those six receiving the highest number of votes in each of the three classes make up the executive council which discusses matters before they are put before the general council.

AFFECTS STUDENT BODY

The Council is responsible for many of the social activities enjoyed by high school students. Clubs receive financial aid from the SAA fund. Numerous sport dances are held on Friday nights throughout the year (odd hop, sock hop, Roaring 20's) as well as a prom in the fall. The Council sponsors the senior-faculty game, assemblies and an election for president each year.

The Council works closely with the administration to shape school policy on many matters. In the past, it helped to formulate the smoking policy now in effect. It is now working to solve the problem of vandalism.

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
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IN MEMORIAM . . .
