hello

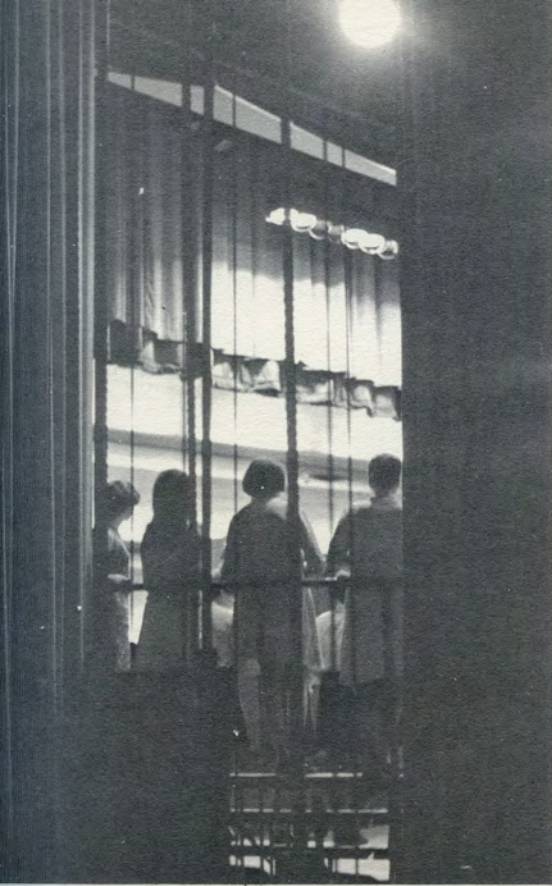
