## What a Great Experience

A real crash course in growing up which has turned out to be one of the greatest experiences in my life. From 800 students in a small school in Kampala, Uganda to M.H.S., a huge one, meant a great adjustment to make and headaches to overcome. 65-85 degrees all year long in Uganda to fall down to zero degrees here in winter wasn't only a shock but a great excitement. Philip E. Stearns, 62, of West Hartford, died Sept. 2.

He was the high school teacher we all wished for - someone inspiring, challenging and caring. To thousands of former students at Manchester High School, Phil Stearns was such a teacher, one never to be forgotten.

"Even when the question may have been dumb, he had a way of taking that stupid question and, very subtly, he would rework it or restate it and add something to it in the answer," said Carl Fenton, a former student. "He would do it so effortlessly, he never made a student feel less intelligent or valued."

Stearns grew up in Canandaigua, N.Y., a small town 30 miles from Rochester, the only child of Clarence and Eleanor Stearns. His father was a Methodist minister but left the ministry to work at a Veterans Administration Hospital. His grandmother and great-grandmother cared for him during his early years when his mother was ill.

At Canandaigua Academy, a public school, Stearns developed his love of literature and theater under the guidance of Jim Lynch, a popular teacher who served as a model for Stearns' own teaching style.

Lynch ran an honors seminar for gifted students that met after-hours at students' houses. He would take them to plays, colleges or to see art movies. With Lynch's guidance, Stearns developed a lifelong love of the theater and Broadway musicals and collected records of their songs. He took school seriously and wrote for the local paper.

The Academy was beginning to welcome foreign students, and a summer he spent in Crete with a Greek family through the American Field Service (AFS) opened his eyes to a new culture and to travel. "He was bitten early by the foreign bug," said a classmate, Doug McNeal.

Stearns went to Colby College in Maine, where he majored in English, and spent several years studying in England. On his return, he obtained a master's degree from the University of Wisconsin. When he interviewed for teaching jobs in Connecticut, Stearns chose to work in Manchester rather than in a Gold Coast town. "He was very committed to working with more challenged people with less privilege," said Stephen Purdy, his longtime domestic partner.

Stearns remained at Manchester High for 35 years' teaching English, until he retired in 2004, carving out a reputation as a caring, hardworking teacher who taught in the honors program as well as mixed-level classes. He sponsored a AFS chapter at the school and for years took students to England during the summer and urged them to explore geography through literature.

The theater enthusiast embraced Hartford Stage, taking students to matinee performances. Although the tickets were sold at a reduced rate, Stearns would buy them himself if there were students who could not afford them. He was especially delighted to escort first-time theatergoers. "They were blown away," said Marilyn Fabian, a retired colleague in the English department.

During a student's junior year, Stearns assigned a research paper of 30 pages on any topic the student found interesting. Field research was required, and under Stearns' guidance, students wrote or talked to people who were famous in their fields.

He would write voluminous comments on the papers, and he would tailor final examination questions to each student's essay topic. His classes were thought provoking.

"He could turn the most innocuous question into something that was profound, so kids could say, 'That's what I really meant.' There was no such thing as a stupid question," said Fabian. "You would have kids who hated English writing 80 pages."

Stearns had a teddy-bear physique and dressed in a way his partner called "proudly rumped," and he talked very quickly. "Twenty minutes later, you'd ask him to take a breath," Purdy said.

He read widely - from Chaucer to T.S. Eliot to Fitzgerald and contemporary writers. The theater continued to be his passion, and he enjoyed traveling. His politics were progressive, and he used to get up at 5 a.m. to read The New York Times before school.

"He could strike up conversations with all sorts of people," said Eric Metcalf, a friend who teaches in New York. "He made conversation an art - a performance. He had a huge vocabulary and could express himself in any number of ways."

Stearns reached out frequently to help students. He helped Zahid Chaudhary, the son of immigrant parents who did not understand the college application procedure, apply to Colby, Stearns' alma mater.

Chaudhary is now an English instructor at Princeton.

"He was incredibly respectful of students," Chaudhary said. "You weren't afraid to be bumbling and let your ignorance show. He made the classroom a really safe space for students to learn."

Stearns developed prostate cancer soon after he retired, and then esophageal cancer.

Fenton said Stearns inspired him to be a teacher. He has taught English as a second language and is now a sergeant major in the Army, supervising a training unit.

"I wasn't real academic in high school, but what appealed to me [is] you can read about heroic figures and about goodness, but very seldom do you see it in action," Fenton said. "Mr. Stearns was just goodness and compassion and sympathy. He was a combination of very intellectual and down to earth, with a dry, very intelligent wit. He would raise his eyebrow, and encourage you to think."
