

I waded in the water, And drew pictures in the sand, My heart felt filled with happiness, As I gazed upon the land.















Though I am among friends I am alone.



In CCIL competition the 1976 track team had a successful season, boasting a 6-3 record in spite of numerous injuries. Several close meets were decided by the 440-Relay team.










## ATS

In the summer of '76 I went to Brasil as an AFS exchange student. I spent about ten weeks in Niteroi, a city of about 400,000 located right across the bay from Rio de Janeiro. My Brazilian family consisted of a mother, father and four sisters. I'm the only son of the family I have no American sisters so it was an enlightening experience having sisters ranging in age from 11 18 years. I now envy and sympathize with guys who have sisters.

My short stay in Brasil enabled me to learn only a little Portuguese, but I managed to communicate and socialize without trouble. It's really amazing how fast you can learn to speak a language when you really have to. Having seen and lived in another culture has helped make me more sensitive to the way people here in the States feel and how their opinions are formed.

Adjusting to Brazilian life and attitudes was difficult. I found it hard, at first, to get used to seeing men carrying shoulder bags. I also found it hard to conform to the Latin macho, which is a very distinct cultural trait of Brasil. Re-adjusting to American ways of thinking has been even harder. Sometimes I catch my Brazilian machismo coming through, or get laughed at for carrying my own shoulder bag, but everything works itself out.

Going abroad is a great deal in lots of ways. I'd never even been on a plane before I went to Brasil, but now that I've taveled I hope never to stop going places. I would heartily recommend that anyone with some imagination and curiosity do some traveling. You'll love it.
