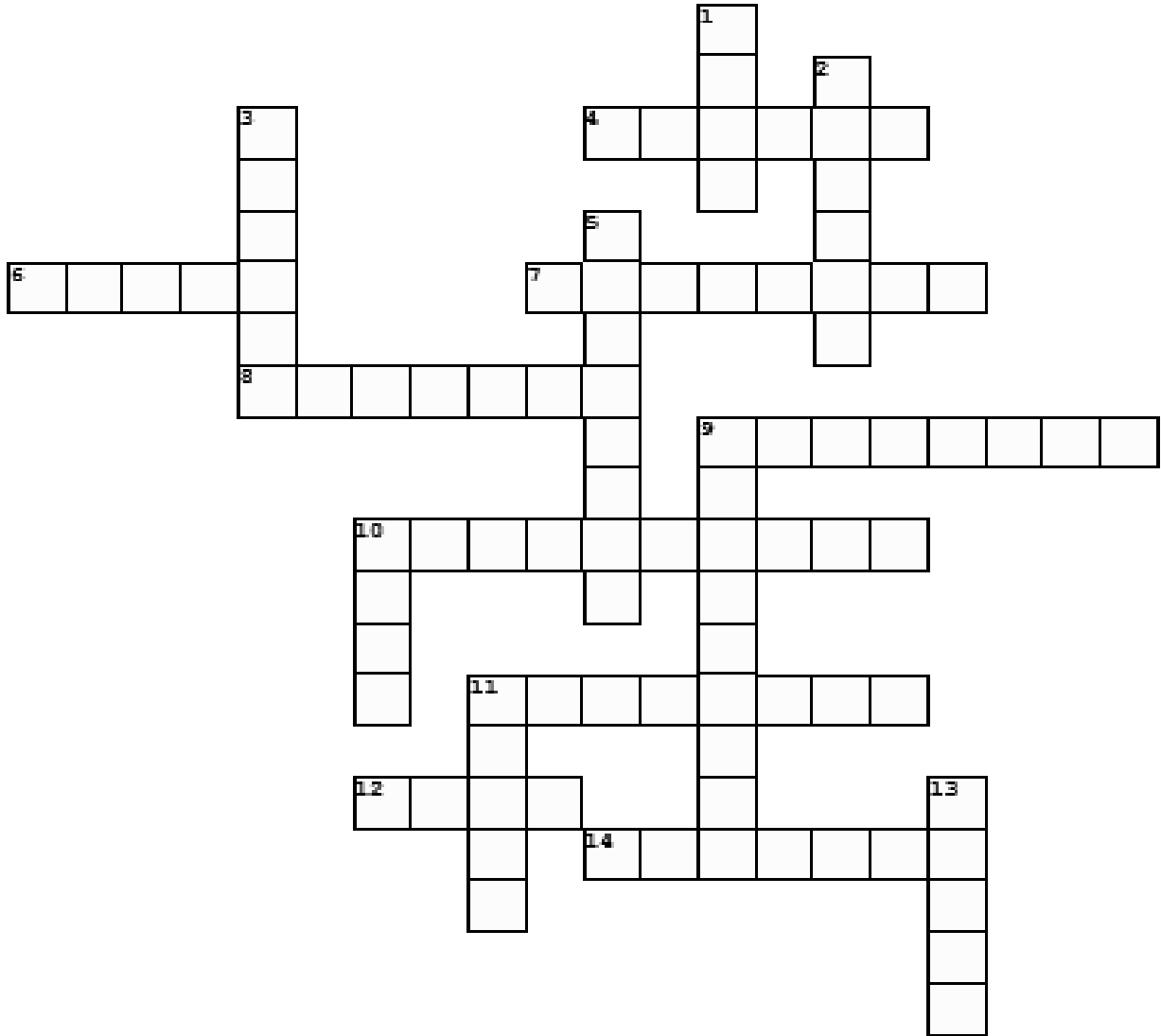

3. Legendary high school track coach Charles "Pete" \_\_\_\_ drafted 1st Road Race course in 1927
5. Residential housing section developed in 1920s north of South Main St; across reservoir from Country Club
9. Award-winning swimmer inducted into Manchester Sports Hall of Fame, 1994. Marcy \_\_\_\_
10. World-famous basketball coach, inducted into Manchester Sports Hall of Fame, 1995. \_\_\_\_ Auriemma
11. Emily \_\_\_\_ (1910-1996), scout leader who took Troop 1 to Europe beginning in 1949
13. Internationally famous Charles Adams \_\_\_\_ (1861-1933), designed mansions on Great Lawn & flag pavilion, Center Park
